NOTICE OF LAST DAY TO FILE CLAIMS

On August 22, 2007, the following debtors (each a "Debtor" and collectively the "Debtors") commenced cases under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"), which process was recognized by the Ontario Superior Court of Justice by an Order dated August 31, 2007:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on December 19, 2007, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware entered an Order establishing **March 4, 2008** at 4:00 p.m. prevailing Eastern time (the "Bar Date") as the last date and time to file a proof of claim against any of the Debtors.

1. WHO MUST FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM

You MUST file a proof of claim if you have a claim against a Debtor that: (a) arose prior to August 22, 2007 and (b) is not an Excluded Claim (as hereinafter defined).

Under Section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code and as used in this Notice, the word "claim" means: (a) a right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, secured, or unsecured; or (b) a right to an equitable remedy for breach of performance if such breach gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right to an equitable remedy is reduced to judgment, fixed,

contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, secured or unsecured. Because of this broad definition, acts or omissions of the Debtors that arose before August 22, 2007 may give rise to claims against them notwithstanding that such claims may not have matured or become fixed or liquidated prior to such date.

THE BAR DATE APPLIES ONLY TO CLAIMS AND NOT TO EQUITY INTERESTS IN THE DEBTORS. HOLDERS OF EQUITY INTERESTS IN THE DEBTORS SHOULD NOT FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM FORM ON ACCOUNT OF SUCH INTERESTS. HOLDERS OF EQUITY INTERESTS WILL BE NOTIFIED IF A DEADLINE IS ESTABLISHED FOR THE FILING OF PROOFS OF INTEREST AGAINST THE DEBTORS.

2. EXCLUDED CLAIMS

You should not file any proof of claim that is an Excluded Claim. "Excluded Claims" include the following types of claims:

- A claim that *already* has been properly filed with the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware or the Claims Agent (as defined below);
- A claim that is: (i) listed on the Debtors' Schedules; (ii) *not* described in the Schedules as "disputed," "contingent," or "unliquidated;" and (iii) in the same amount and of the same priority as set forth in the Schedules;
- An administrative expense of any Debtor's chapter 11 case under section 503(b) of the Bankruptcy Code;
- A claim of a Debtor or a non-Debtor subsidiary of a Debtor against a Debtor;
- A claim that has been allowed, paid or otherwise satisfied by or pursuant to an Order of the Court;
- A claim that has been subject to a bar date established by Order of the Court other than the Bar Date Order;
- A claim which is limited exclusively to the repayment by a Debtor of principal and interest (a "Debt Claim") on the Debtors' 9-7/8% Senior Notes Due 2014 (the "Notes") or the indenture in respect of the Notes (the "Indenture"); provided, however, that: (a) the foregoing exclusion under this subparagraph shall not apply to the indenture trustee under the Indenture ("Indenture Trustee"); (b) the Indenture Trustee shall be required to file a proof of claim on account of the Debt Claim on or before the Bar Date; and (c) any holder of Notes that wishes to assert a claim arising out of or relating to a Debt Claim, other than the Notes, shall be required to file a proof of claim on or before the Bar Date, unless another exception identified herein applies; and
- An asserted administrative expense claim pursuant to section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code that is filed in accordance with the bar date established in the Court's Order entered August 28, 2007 [D.I. 67], but which is determined to be a priority, general unsecured or secured claim rather than an administrative expense claim.

3. WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE

To file a claim, you must do the following:

- Return your completed Proof of Claim Form(s) to Logan & Company, Inc. (the "Claims Agent") no later than 4:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern time, **March 4, 2008**. Proof of Claim Forms will be deemed filed only when **actually received** by the Claims Agent. Proof of Claim Forms submitted by electronic submission or by facsimile will **not** be accepted and will not be deemed filed.
- Your filed Proof of Claim Form must: (i) be written in English; (ii) be denominated in lawful currency of the United States, based upon the exchange rate in effect as of the Petition Date, if applicable; (iii) conform substantially with the Proof of Claim Form approved by the Court; and (iv) provide the full name of the specific Debtor against which your claim is asserted. To expedite the processing of your claim, use the Proof of Claim Form approved for use in these cases.

4. CLAIMS AGAINST MULTIPLE DEBTORS

If you assert claims against more than one of the Debtors, you must file a separate Proof of Claim Form asserting each such claim against the appropriate Debtor. If you file a single Proof of Claim Form asserting a claim against more than one Debtor, your claim will be deemed to have been filed against the first Debtor identified only. All additional identified Debtors will be disregarded.

5. EFFECT OF NOT FILING A CLAIM

IF YOU ARE REQUIRED TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM FORM AND DO NOT DO SO ON OR BEFORE THE BAR DATE OF MARCH 4, 2008, YOU WILL BE FOREVER BARRED, ESTOPPED, AND ENJOINED FROM ASSERTING SUCH CLAIM AGAINST ANY OF THE DEBTORS AND YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO VOTE ON ANY PLAN OF REORGANIZATION OR PARTICIPATE IN ANY DISTRIBUTION ON ACCOUNT OF SUCH CLAIM OR RECEIVE FURTHER NOTICES REGARDING SUCH CLAIM.

PURSUANT TO THE ORDER OF THE ONTARIO SUPERIOR COURT OF JUSTICE DATED JANUARY 11, 2008, THE BAR DATE SHALL ALSO APPLY TO CANADIAN CREDITORS WITH CLAIMS AGAINST ANY DEBTOR.
